Subject:	Unit & Content Overview:
English	Continuing to develop our phonic knowledge. What's for Tea? Alice in Wonderland, The Teenager who came to Tea, the Mad Hatter's Tea Party Author Study: Lewis Carroll
Maths	Number & Place Value, Mental +, -, x & ÷, Fractions Shape, Space, Measure, Geometry - position & direction, Properties of shape, Measurement, Mental Statistics <i>Students will use Numicon and Base 10 to support their learning and to deepen key concepts.</i>
Science	Earth & Space - <i>Learning about the different things we can find in space and the difference between daytime and night-time.</i> Light and Sound - <i>How light and sound are made and how they can be changed for different purposes.</i>
Computing	Developing our typing skills, ability to draw images, understanding of the left click functions and understanding of coding.
PE	Athletics & Outdoor Education - <i>Improving core athletic running, jumping and throwing skills and taking part in a large competition at Disport.</i>
DT	Food: <i>Healthy, Seasonal and British food. Looking at cooking and baking nutritional seasonal British dishes.</i>
MFL - French	What's the Weather Like? Difference between hot and cold.
Music	Festival & Rock 'n' Roll - Rock Around the Clock: <i>To perform as part of a group in the Scunthorpe Music festival. To perform as a part of a group Rock Around the Clock.</i>
RE	Our World: <i>Creation & Citizenship - Students will learn how Christians believe the world was created. They will consider the beauty of the world and how we all have a responsibility to care for it.</i>
Art	Journeys: <i>explore ideas about journeys; collect information about signs and symbols, investigate lines, shapes, colours and textures to produce work on the theme of journeys; combine a variety of painting, print-making and collage techniques to enhance their work.</i>
