

Subject:	Unit & Content Overview:
English	<p><b>GCSE:</b> A Christmas Carol, Poetry 2: English Literature Paper 1 &amp; Paper 2, <b>ELC:</b> HA: Gold Step Component 1 - Detectives, MA: Silver Step Component 1 - Detectives <b>Unit Award:</b> Media - Reading, Writing and Speaking and Listening <b>Pre-Entry Unit Awards:</b> Media: Newspaper and Headline Features <b>Personal Progress:</b> Developing Writing Skills</p> <p>Students will continue their studies within personalised accreditation routes from one or more of the following programmes of study: <b>GCSE, Entry Level certificates, Pre-Entry Unit Awards and Personal Progress</b> Strands covered will include place value, multiplication, division, addition, subtraction, time, properties of shape, statistics, money and position and direction</p>
Maths	<p>Students will be learning about the environment, evolution and inheritance. They will investigate ecosystems and how animals can adapt to survive, as well as how genetic information is passed down to offspring.</p> <p>Students will develop improving productivity using ICT. The students will be given a series of tasks to complete and they must choose which computer software would allow them to complete the task effectively.</p>
Science	<p><i>Students will develop their fundamental skills in Football, Table Tennis and Trampolining for their ECL qualification.</i></p>
Computing	<p>Students will explore the key question: What is God? They will look at a range of beliefs about God and how these beliefs have changed over time. They will consider whether there is a God and reflect on their own views about God.</p> <p>Students will be developing their understanding of Relationship and Sex Education.</p>
PE	<p>Students will use map skills to explore features of interest in the local area. Students will be using a web-based site to create maps and routes from school to local places. Students then use the routes in the community to walk to the feature of interest.</p>
RE	<p>Students will explore line, shape, colour, pattern and texture within Street Art. They will make observations and analyse the work of street artists. They will produce a range of designs, images and samples using techniques such as drawing, stencilling and sculpture in order to begin to develop their own street art style.</p> <p><i>Students will be undertaking a unit award in working with wood. They will be designing and making a mirror. They will also undertake a unit on health and safety.</i></p>
PHSE	<p>Students will be undertaking two BTEC units simultaneously. One of the units is concerned with Serving Food and Drinks and will be completed by students putting together a coffee morning. The other unit considers basic food preparation, which develops skills such as hygiene, safety and equipment.</p>
Geography	<p>Students will develop their understanding and participate in a range of different exercise and fitness activities.</p> <p>Students will be undertaking a unit of work on music production and performance. Students will either develop a performance using an existing piece of music or create their own to then perform to an audience.</p>
