Dear Parents/Carers

We are planning to take students in KS5NT on two educational visits over the next 3 weeks. These visits will form part of their Christmas community experiences but also part of their Core Skills work to explore maths and English in environments which are representative of the wider UK.

We are planning to visit Normanby Park on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> November followed by lunch at the Queensway Hungry Horse pub in Scunthorpe. The students will be transported by bus to and from the park and to the Queensway. The group will then walk back to school after lunch. On Thursday December 6<sup>th</sup>, we are planning a visit to Brigg Garden Centre to experience the Christmas light displays and decorations followed by lunch in the restaurant. We will then be transported to Brigg High Street to visit the market and look at the boats at the river side.

Students will be supported to choose appropriate meals at affordable prices on both visits but, as prices vary, we will contact you individually via their student journal, if they require any further funds. In order to facilitate the cost of the visit on Thursday December 6<sup>th</sup>, we will return to school on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> December for a school lunch rather than eating out in the community. We appreciate your continued support in our community based learning.

Minibus transport has been arranged for both visits and we are asking for parental contributions of £6 to cover the costs of both buses.
