Recently the Government implemented a new sugar tax .The UK-wide soft drinks levy comes into force next month and is to be applied to companies that produce beverages with added sugar. It is hoping that through the sugar tax it will provide £26m for schools around the country to expand the current breakfast clubs they offer.

The idea behind this new investment is that it "will ensure a nutritious breakfast reaches many more thousands of hungry schoolchildren, unlocking up to four hours of learning each morning to support their education".

We are proud to be part of this programme and would welcome your child to join us for a great start to the day. The new breakfast club will be launched for Key Stage 3 pupils on March 4th and for Key Stage 4 on 11th March. Pupils will be able to enjoy a free breakfast from some of the choices below:
