Dear Parents/Carers,

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all parents and carers for the support you have shown during this period of time.

In line with current Government guidance including the social distance requirement and the updated information for people that may be shielding. School has been risk assessed to be able, as safely as possible, provide 60 spaces for students.

We have many different scenerios for our families and students. Some of you have been able to secure a place and able to attend school. Some of you have made the decision due to personal reasons or underlying medical reasons that it is more appropriate to remain at home and school are supporting those students with contact calls throughout the week.

School organisation will look differently from the new academic year in September 2020. Dependant on Government guidance unless the social distance rule is cancelled altogether, we will possibly use a rota system to help support this. Therefore it is likely that students attendance will be part time with only a limited number of students accessing school meals. For our students with underlying conditions who it is deemed safer not to return to school we are identifying how we can support virtually and more regularly.

You may all be aware that the Government have announced that they will support those eligible students throughout this Summer holiday with Free School Meals. We are awaiting further guidance on how this will be rolled out but it will likely be with a voucher scheme. As soon as we have more details we will contact those families with more information.

We are working hard to communicate our plans to you before the 13th July 2020. It is important that we maintain systems in school that will help support track and trace if any staff or students in school do become unwell due to the virus in order to shut down bubbles and a virus test accessed.
