



In autumn term 2019, 9/10SR will be learning about....

Subject:	Unit & Content Overview:
English	The theme this term is Macbeth which will be taught in a sensory way. The students will continue to develop their skills in spelling, reading and writing.
Maths	Students will cover basic fluency skills in number and work on addition and subtraction. They will also explore shape and measures in a practical way.
Science	Students will be exploring humans as organisms with a sensory approach, as well as investigating cells with microscopes.
Computing	Students will learn about keeping safe online, using a browser for effective searching, creating their own 3D game and technologies outside of school.
PE	The students will take part in a range of games including cricket, boccia and basketball.
DT	Students will be designing and making a bird box. They will investigate birds and bird shelters to help support their work. Students will use a range of hand tools and computer aided manufacture as part of their work.
Music	Things That Go Bump in the Night; Students to identify how certain instruments are played, e.g shake, hit, pluck etc, and what sounds they make. Also they will explore how music can go fast and slow, high and low, and loud and soft. They will create sound effects to sound like events in a haunted house.
RE	Students will explore a range of creation stories and sequence key events. They will have an opportunity to participate in role play to act out key scenes.
Art	Students will create 2D work based on the theme of landscapes. They will learn to manipulate the visual and tactile qualities of materials. They will collect visual and other information by visiting a landscape and by studying the methods, approaches and intentions of 3 different artists who use the environment as inspiration.
PSHE	<i>Relationships and Sex Education - Students will develop and understanding of their body, different types of relationships and how they can keep safe.</i>
Humanities (History)	Students will be exploring life in the Victorian time for children focusing on toys and hobbies.
