- Health and social care - doctors, nurses, midwives, paramedics, social workers, care workers, frontline health and social care staff including volunteers; support and specialist staff; health and social care supply chain, producers and distributors of medicines and medical and personal protective equipment.
- Education and childcare - nursery and teaching staff, social workers and specialist education professionals.
- Key public services - justice system, religious staff, charities, key frontline services, management of the deceased, journalists and broadcasters who are providing public service broadcasting.
- Local and national government - administrative occupations delivering essential public services such as the payment of benefits, including in government agencies and arms length bodies.
- Food and other necessary goods - food production, processing, distribution, sale and delivery of provision of other key goods (for example hygienic and veterinary medicine).
- Public safety and national security - police and support staff, Ministry of Defence civilians, contractor and armed forces personnel, key defence and national security, fire and rescue service, National Crime Agency, border security, prison and probation staff and other national security roles, including those overseas.
- Transport - air, water, road and rail passenger and freight transport, transport systems through which supply chains pass.
- Utilities, communication and financial services - building societies and financial market infrastructure, oil, gas, electricity and water sectors (including sewerage), information technology and data infrastructure, primary industry supplies, civil nuclear, chemicals, telecommunications, network operations, field engineering, call centre staff, IT and data infrastructure, 999 and 111 critical services), postal services and delivery, payments providers and waste disposal sectors.
