

In spring term 2020, 9/10SR will be learning about....

Subject:	Unit & Content Overview:
English	Students will explore Leisure as the main theme for their English. They will use non fiction sources to collect information about leisure facilities and leisure activities. Students will record their thoughts and their ideas using a variety of non fiction writing styles. Year 10 will complete accreditation based on this theme.
Maths	In maths the students will re visit basic maths skills of number, calculation and place value. They will also complete work based on multiplication and division and statistics (representing data). These are the two units the year 10 students will gain for accreditation this term. Alongside the students will cover money and time. Maths fluency will continue to be taught.
Science	Year 10 students will be completing unit awards aimed at exploring different materials and reactions. They will also investigate the properties of different materials and their uses. Year 9 will work on units linked to exploring properties of materials and how they change. They will also look at how materials are used for various jobs and reasons why.
Computing	Students will follow a BTEC Personal Progress Unit called Developing ICT Skills. The students are going to create a series of e-books using both written words and digital images. The students will learn how to embed images into an e-book and then present them to an audience.
PE	Students will complete a unit based on health related fitness. They will explore activities which can help them stay fit and learn why this is important. Then they will learn about how healthy eating supports their exercise routine. We will also complete a unit on basic football skills, controlling and passing a football and playing small sided games.
DT	In DT the students will be exploring food from different cultures. They will look at recipes and make food. They will learn about safety in the kitchen and the importance of hygiene. The year 10 students will gain accreditation in this unit. They will also complete a unit on buffet and picnic food working towards preparing food for a social event.
Music	In Music the students will continue to explore the Chinese pentatonic scale and experience instruments using this five-note scale, as well as taking part in a Chinese New Year Parade using rhythm to dictate a dragon/lion dance.
RE	Students will be learning about freedom and justice and exploring about what different religions teach about this concept. Through stories and parables, students will improve their understanding about choice and conflict and how they can resolve conflict in a positive way.
Art	Students will create 2D work based on the theme of landscapes. They will learn to manipulate the visual and tactile qualities of materials. They will collect visual and other information by visiting a landscape and by studying the methods, approaches and intentions of 3 different artists who use the environment as inspiration.
PSHE	This term students will be developing their understanding of what is in their community and how they can become an effective community citizen.
Humanities (History)	This term the students will be exploring countries in Asia. They will look at maps and find towns and cities. They will compare climate, facilities and food to their experiences of the local area.
