Dear Parent/ Carers

Following the government guidance for schools to report any positive cases and take the necessary steps, we ask parents/carers to please follow the below guidance:

- If your child develops symptoms on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> February or Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2021 and they have to be booked to have a test, we ask that parents/carers please immediately contact school and leave the following details:-
  - Name of who is being tested or has tested positive
  - Postcode
  - Age
  - Date symptoms started
  - Date of test
  - Date they were last in school
  - Send details to [admin.sthughs@northlincs.gov.uk](mailto:admin.sthughs@northlincs.gov.uk)
- Parents/carers **do not** need to contact school if the symptoms developed after Sunday the 14<sup>th</sup> February 2021. The cut-off date for reporting a positive test result to school will be **3pm Monday 15<sup>th</sup> 2021**, unless it is directly agreed with school to be any other due to exceptional circumstances.

If your child was absent from school with symptoms before Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2021 and you receive a positive test result after school closes, please report the positive test to school as soon as you receive it.

For those families that receive Free School Meals (FSM), North Lincolnshire Council will be issuing vouchers to cover the February half term. Please contact school if you require further details.
