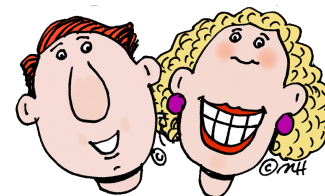


Parental Feedback on Parents Evening: May 13
