Safeguarding in school / at school events

At St Hugh's we have strict rules around the safeguarding of our students and visitors to the site.

Parents / carers will always be asked to sign in and wear an identity sticker whilst in the building.

Once in the building (unless parents / carers are on the schools central register, and have a current CRB in place), they will be escorted around the building by staff who work in the school. This means that if parents / carers need to visit the toilet or return to the front entrance, they cannot go without a member of St Hugh's staff being with them.

If parents / carers need to go to toilet whilst they are visiting the school, they will be escorted to the visitor's toilets at the front of school and under **no circumstances** should they use the student's toilets.

Parents / carers will also be asked to sign out, as part of our process, when they the leave the building.

We hope as a school that you appreciate our efforts to keep your children safe under the guidelines set by the LSCB (Local Safeguarding Children's board).
