

## Pathway 1 LTP

### Curriculum Content:

Pathway 1 students have a focused curriculum based on their age, interests, motivations, development, and unique starting points. It is built around the individual student, strongly reflecting our whole school motto 'Learning Together, Learning for Life'. The curriculum will focus on four key areas linked to the areas of the Education and Health Care Plan (EHCP):

- Communication
- Cognition
- Physical and Sensory
- Social and Emotional Wellbeing
- Independence (for Complex ASD students only. This curriculum area is highly individualised and usually centred around personal care routines such as toileting, feeding and dressing).

SMSC opportunities, although not a formal part of this curriculum, are regularly planned to ensure that students have access to a broad and balanced curriculum. Pathway 1 students also participate in extended 'Diversity Day' experiences (at least three days per term) alongside students in Pathways 2 and 3.

Each student has a Personalised Learning Plan (PLP) broken down into each of the curriculum areas above. These plans include long term outcomes, annual outcomes and 'building blocks' as well as information on how the student accesses learning in each area and how best to support them. Where personalised outcomes may overlap curriculum content areas, a best fit judgement is made by the class teacher responsible for the completion of the PLP. Each plan also has an aspirational outcome for the end of the students' key stage to ensure that we have a clear and consistent focus of where we want to see the individual student at key transition points in their lives. This ensures that long-term outcomes and 'building blocks' have an appropriate level of challenge and work towards our longer-term aspirations. Within their PLP, students also have an individual engagement profile that details how each student engages in the five key areas of exploration, realisation, anticipation, persistence, and initiation. These are continually updated as students make progress within the five areas of engagement.
